2004 - present - 1/2house (with Syverson Monteyne Architecture) stretches north to south on a gently sloping river site in a prominent and desirable Winnipeg location.

The 2300 sq.ft. home features a generous open plan especially suited for the clients modern lifestyle. Open web 'Posi-Trusses' span 24' between 72' long bearing walls, alleviating the need for interior structural partitions. The shed roof defines a simple geometry and volume. Outdoor porches and entry court are carved from the volume to reveal a subtractive formal gesture in contrast to its neighbors.

The unfinished cedar screen wall stands in strong contrast to the fleshy red innards of the pre-finished 'hardi-panel'.

My responsibilities as lead designer and job captain include conceptual design, design development, construction documents, presentation materials, project administration and coordination. This project is currently in early construction.
